OVERALL PURPOSE OF JOB

To work as part of a team monitoring pupil behaviour during the midday break to ensure a caring and safe environment. Required to work indoors and outdoors when supervising the children and young people to ensure their safety.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES		
1	Supervise the playground area, playing fields, cloakrooms, classrooms etc. during the lunchtime break.	
2	Assist with the removal of food and equipment once pupils have eaten their lunch.	
3	Deal with minor first aid incidents; follow appropriate procedures for recording and reporting.	
4	Assist in the implementation of appropriate behaviour management strategies as required	
5	Observe a child or young person's behaviour, understand its context, and notice any unexpected changes and report any inappropriate behaviour to the correct member of staff.	
6	Resolve minor disputes between pupils	
7	Assist in the supervision of other activities during the midday break, including setting out and storing equipment	
8	Report any concerns about pupil welfare to the appropriate member of staff in a confidential manner.	
9	Establish rapport and respectful, trusting relationships with children, young people and those caring for them.	
10	Provide support and encouragement to children and young people.

2	Comply with Child Safeguarding Procedures and adhere to the Trust's Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy at all times.
